Smear review for schistocytes

Fibrin Split Products (FSP)/Fibrin degradation products (FDP) is no longer part of the DIC panel due to a recurring national shortage of the special FSP tubes, testing supplies and the minimal impact of FSP result on DIC interpretation. If a FSP is specifically requested it will be sent to ARUP, our primary reference lab, which has an expected result in 2-4 days.

The specimen requirements and test result turn-around-time for the rest of the DIC panel components are unchanged.
