CORTISOL TESTING UPDATE

Effective February 1, 2021 the following changes are in effect:

- 1. New Cortisol Stimulation (Corsynthropin Stimulation) Testing Order set
- 2. Updated cortisol reference range for cortisol dexamethasone suppression test

<u>Cortisol Stimulation Testing (Corsynthropin Stimulation testing)</u>

Order set includes:

Cortisol Baseline Cortisol 30 minutes Cortisol 60 minutes ACTH

Cortisol Dexamethasone Suppression Testing

(this is NOT an order set; each test requires an individual order)

- 1. Dexamethasone level
 - a. Reference range: normal <50 ng/dl
 - b. Sent to ARUP reference laboratory
- 2. Cortisol level (Cortisol Dexamethasone suppression)
 - a. Cortisol level performed at Methodist pathology
 - b. Reference range: normal < 1.8 ug/dl (only for suppression testing)

There are no changes in the *individual* Cortisol and ACTH tests. This information is included for completeness.

Cortisol test, random (Cortisol level)

- 1. Performed at Methodist pathology
- 2. Critical value: < 2.0 ug/dl
- 3. Reference range (interpretive data)

AM: 6.2-29 ug/dL PM: 3.0-17.3 ug/dL

ACTH test, random (Adrenocorticotropic Hormone level)

- 1. Sent to ARUP reference laboratory
- 2. Reference range: 7.2-63.3 pg/ml (am draw)

Specimen requirements for the tests have not changed.
